Funtown Frightfest Spooky Ghoul Carnival Fun-draiser To Benefit Las Vegas School Groups and Clubs

The 1st Annual Clark County School District (CCSD) Spooky Ghoul Carnival Fun-draiser will be held this October at Funtown Frightfest (at Boca Park in Summerlin) and Funtown Frightfest II (at Galleria Mall in Henderson). The event will help local area students raise money for their favorite school group by providing free carnival booth space to Parent Teacher Associations and other recognized school organizations or clubs in the Clark County School District. Participating organizations will develop a fundraising concept for the event, decorate and staff their booths, and keep all of the proceeds for their school group or club.

"PTA's and student organizations from all over the Valley are invited to participate, which occasionally leads to some friendly competition between both inter-school groups and so-called school rivals," said DJ Pellegrino, special event coordinator for Funtown Frightfest. "But it's just that competitive aspect that puts the "fun" in fun-draising and makes this event so exciting."

In addition to an assortment of school group fun-draising booths, the 2009 Clark County School District Spooky Ghoul Carnival will feature plenty of fun, food and frights including carnival rides, midway games, haunted houses, pony rides, haunted train, pumpkin patch, live entertainment, spooky-oke (karaoke), costume contests, live radio remotes, special celebrity appearances, booth contests and much more.

The fundraiser will take place at both Summerlin and Henderson locations on three separate dates. The Elementary School Ghoul Carnival, open to grades 1 – 5, will take place Saturday, October 17, from 12 noon – 8pm. The Middle School Ghoul Carnival, open to grades 6 - 8, is Tuesday, October 20, from 5pm-10pm. The High School Ghoul Carnival, open to grades 9 – 12, will take place Tuesday, October 27, from 5pm-10pm.

Admission is \$3 for Adults, \$2 for Children under 12 or \$10 for a Family Fun Pack, and includes free popcorn or soda. Admission to the Spooky Ghoul Carnival Fun-draiser events is free with printable coupon available online.

Booth concepts are subject to approval and available on a first come/first serve basis, so school organizations and groups wishing to participate are encouraged to register early. Ghoul Carnival registration forms can be found online at www.funtownfrightfest.com.
